

2018-2019 Junior Leadership Granbury Policies

Cost

There is no cost to participate in Junior Leadership Granbury.

Transportation

Students are responsible for their own transportation to and from all scheduled sessions. Assistance is available if arrangements are made with the leaders in advance.

Code of Conduct

Each participant in Junior Leadership Granbury is an exceptional young person. Therefore, expectations are high for each scheduled session during the course of this program. To be certain of an understanding about the expected standards of conduct, you and your parents or guardians need to be aware of several important factors. First, you are participating with the approval and support of your school and must abide by the same general set of rules and regulations set forth by your respective school system. Second, your parents or guardians are responsible for your conduct while participating in the various programs making up the Junior Leadership Granbury curriculum. Finally, all participants are expected to abide by the following standards:

1. To participate in all activities as scheduled.
2. To be on time for each session, remain until the scheduled activity is concluded, and agree to leave the assigned facility or location at scheduled times only.
3. To use only the transportation provided by Junior Leadership Granbury, provided by your parents or guardians, or that is specifically approved by your parents or guardians as solely for the purpose of attendance at a Junior Leadership Granbury event or activity.
4. To conduct yourself and dress in a manner appropriate to the scheduled activity or presentation, and to follow a code of ethical behavior at all times during any Junior Leadership Granbury event or activity.
5. To refrain from having any friends or family visit during scheduled programs, class sessions or events.
6. To completely abstain from the use of any alcohol, tobacco, or drugs.
7. To participate in the graduation banquet as scheduled. (Friends and family are included.)

Attendance Policy

In order to achieve the objectives of the Junior Leadership Granbury program, full attendance is expected by each participant. More than two unexcused absences will prevent you from completing the program. However, absences may be excused if you notify the leaders in advance. This year's class will ordinarily meet in the evenings once per month, with dates to be determined. The first and second class will be daytime classes where we join with the Adult Leadership class; the first class is on September 12. There may be additional events which will serve as make-up credit for any missed meetings. Those will be announced throughout the year. Please advise the leaders as soon as possible of any sessions in which you may have a conflict.
